The Senior Band will be giving an open air concert with a German youth orchestra at Abergavenny Castle, celebrating the arrival of the Olympic Torch in the town. Tickets are available through the Borough Theatre Box Office and the programme will feature fireworks and a rendition of the 1812 Overture. Unfortunately the junior band will not be participating in this one, but we would still love to see you there.

Solos, Quartets and Ensembles Competition - Saturday 9 June 2012

This takes place at the YMCA, Mendalgief Road, Newport, and is open to players of all ages. The various classes are listed on the attached sheet. Solos will take place in the morning and guartets and other groups in the afternoon.

We would like as many of our beginners as possible to enter Class A – Slow Melody 11 years and under. It's a great opportunity to show off your new skills even if you only play a simple tune. Colin or Lana or your teacher at school will help you to choose a suitable piece. A pianist will be on duty so you can even play with piano accompaniment. Older players can enter both slow melody and air varie classes.

We will also be entering some quartets and larger groups in the competition but we need to know who is available before we assemble them. Soloists between 11 and 18 years old should also make their own entries, but please let me know if you would be interested in playing in a small group and we will see what we can put together.
